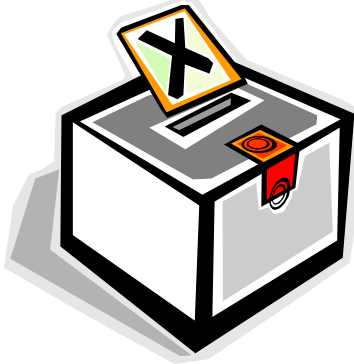

## Napa Valley Symphony



We have been getting reports from our members and from other locals that the Napa Valley Symphony (NVS) — not a Local 12 orchestra— has not been paying its musicians in a timely fashion. While musicians have eventually been paid for work done prior to this last November concert, it was not, in most cases, without considerable delays.

Most NVS musicians are aware of the problem, however substitute and extra musicians may not be. If you are asked to perform with the NVS we recommend that you ask when you will get paid and that you regard any such date given as no more than a "guesstimate" and base your decision to accept work there accordingly.

We wish the members of the Napa Valley Symphony well and trust that eventually things will begin to turn around, and the NVS will return to being a viable entity and a reliable employer of our region's musicians. Please call Local 12 if you have any questions.

### Suspension Policy

Any members whose Regular or  
Life Membership Dues remain unpaid

twenty-five dollars, plus back standing  
dues and late fees of five dollars per  
quarter in order to resume membership

in addition to the reinstatement plus  
quarterly late fees.

## Agenda Item for Member Meeting February 7, 2008

### Resolution: Officers' Salaries

**Whereas**, the membership of Local #12 approved a revision to the Local #12 bylaws effective May 2007; and

**Whereas**, said revision contains a redistribution of the responsibilities of the former offices of President, Secretary/Business Agent and Treasurer to the re-configured offices of President and Secretary-Treasurer, and the newly-created office of Recording Secretary with term beginning January 1, 2008; and

**Whereas**, said revision indicates in Section 7, for the offices of President, Secretary-Treasurer, and Recording Secretary, "Compensation for his/her services shall be set by the Board, subject to the approval of the general membership;" and

**Whereas**, it is the stated intent of the Bylaw Revision Committee which drafted said revision that there should be no economic impact on the Local #12 annual budget due to the redistribution of responsibilities contained in the Local #12 Bylaw revision effective May 2007, aside from the Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) guaranteed by Section 7 of the Local #12 Bylaws;

**Therefore, be it resolved** that the Board of Directors approves the following salaries for the offices of President, Secretary-Treasurer and Recording Secretary, effective January 1, 2008, and subject to the approval of the membership per Section 7 of the Local #12 bylaws:

President	A wage equal to that of the former office of Secretary/Business Agent, plus COLA per Section 7, Local #12 Bylaws
Secretary-Treasurer	A wage equal to that of the former office of Treasurer, plus COLA per Section 7, Local #12 Bylaws
Recording Secretary	A wage equal to that of the former office of President, plus COLA per Section 7, Local #12 bylaws

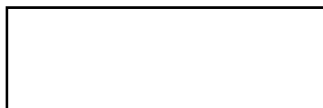
